



## ORGANIZATION RULES

### **Player Rules**

- 1) You must be at the rink for practice and games at the coach's specified time.  
**Violation Result-** Player will sit 1 period at the next game.
- 2) No horseplay in the locker room.  
**Violation Result-** Player will sit the entire next game.
- 3) The locker room is to be spotless after every game and practice.  
**Violation Result-** Additional skating at next practice.
- 4) You must notify and be excused by the coach if you will be late or not attending any team event.  
**Violation Result-** Player will sit 1 period at the next game for every event missed or more if the coach deems necessary.
- 5) Only the captain and assistants may talk to officials.  
**Violation Result-** Player will not play the remainder of the game and possibly the next game.
- 6) You may never address the official in a demeaning manner.  
**Violation Result-** Player will not play the remainder of the game and possibly the next game.
- 7) You must treat every teammate and coach with respect at all times.  
**Violation Result-** Player will not play the next game and possibly the following game.
- 8) You must come to practice and games with a good attitude.  
**Violation Result-** Player will be excused from that event and possibly the next.

### **Spectator Rules**

- 1) Spectators should never address officials, opposing players, or opposing spectators in a negative way.  
**Violation Result-** Spectator will be suspended from attending the next game or more.
- 2) 24 hour rule – No player or parent may contact a coach or manager until 24 hours after a game.  
**Violation Result-** Spectator will be suspended from attending the next game or more.
- 3) Keep it fun!

These rules are being implemented to ensure that the Kings have an organization operated with class and integrity. The Kings retain the right to implement further suspensions if they see fit. There will be no warnings or second chances. This is all for the good of the players, coaches, spectators, and game.
